<sup>(1)</sup> Included in the pro forma net charge-off rate are those net losses associated with purchased credit card receivables. Under GAAP, losses associated with purchased credit card receivables are reflected in the fair value of the purchased credit card receivables and not reported as net charge-offs. The Company believes that it is meaningful to investors to see the net charge-off rate that includes net losses on these acquired credit card receivables as it is more indicative of a normalized loss rate.
